Read. Study. Pray. offers a simple way to engage Sunday's scripture during the week. **Begin with Acts 2;42-47.** Read slowly. Read once for flow, then again for meaning. Notice repeated words and the speaker. Move to study by choosing one verse. Ask clear questions. Who speaks. What promise appears. What brings surprise. Use a brief Bible note or talk with others if helpful. Then pray. Thank God for a blessing named in the passage. Practice one teaching during the week. Pray for those preparing to teach and lead on Sunday. Sit quietly for a moment. Start small. Return to the passage during the week.

At Newburg United Methodist Church, we strive to make a difference in communities both close to home and across the country. We believe that, as people, sharing our gifts with others helps lift our community, as well as those around us.

This summer, a team of adults from our congregation will travel to Alaska to serve alongside our neighbors at Alaska Pacific University (APU). APU hosts volunteer groups year-round and provides housing in onsite yurts. Unfortunately, those yurts were recently destroyed in a storm, preventing APU from welcoming volunteers needed for important community projects.

Through our conference, Newburg UMC has been partnered with APU to help restore their volunteer housing. During our week in Alaska, we will assist with repairs, support APU's community gardening program that provides fresh food to local residents, and help care for their community apple orchard.

Ten dedicated individuals are preparing for this mission trip in July, and we need your help to make it possible. 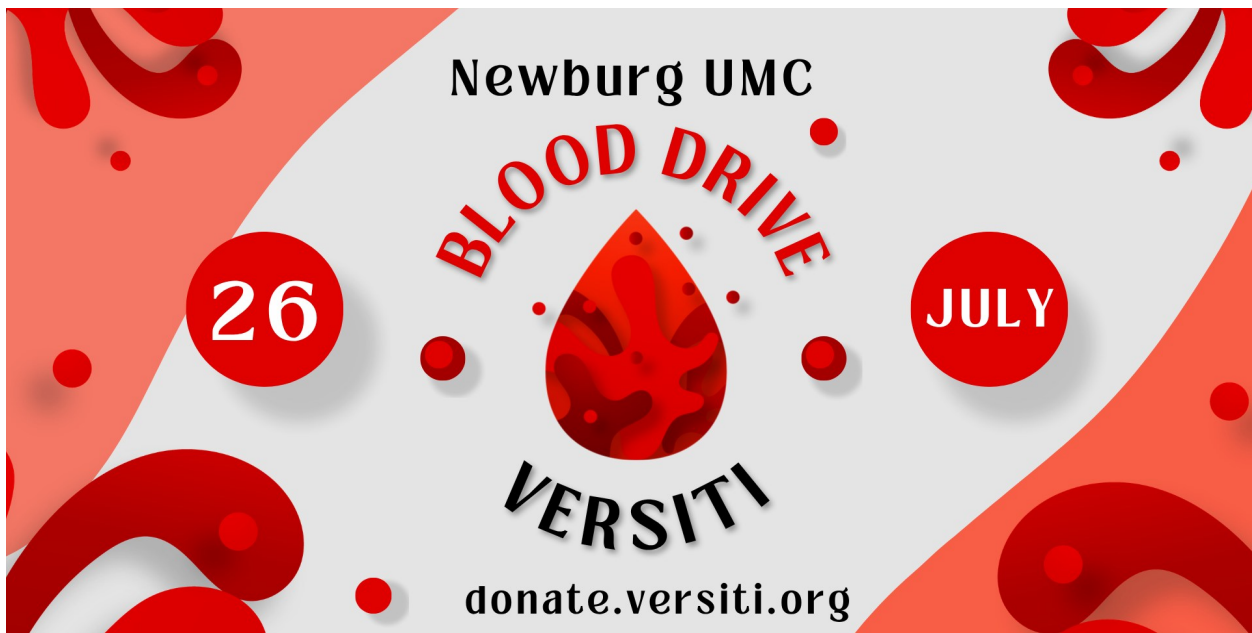
